#### How does the laser work?

The laser light passes through the toenail without causing damage to the nail or the, surrounding skin. At the time of the procedure, the toenail will not become instantly clear, as it takes time to grow out. Final results can be seen in 4-12 months.

## What can I expect in the provider's office?

A consultation with your provider, the procedure to be performed, and any follow-up visits as prescribed by your provider.

#### Is the prodecure painful?

Most people feel no pain. Some people feel a warming sensation and very few feel a pinprick.

#### Is there a recovery period?

No, just walk in and walk out.

#### How long does the procedure take?

The FootLaser procedure takes about 30 minutes.

## When can I paint my nails or have a pedicure?

You can apply polish immediately after the treatment. It is important to remove all nail polish and nail decorations the day before your

treatment.

## How do I pay for the procedure?

Credit cards, cash and money orders are all accepted. Eligble patients can also use their medical expenses Flexible Spending Account.


### Is this covered by my insurance?

#### Will the fungus come back?

The infection usually improves following one treatment, however a retreatment in one year is recommended to ensure complete removal of the fungus. There is a chance of reinfection because the fungus is present everywhere in the environment. Please see our office for information on disinfecting and removing fungus from shoes.
